The beautiful exterior of AIREX motorhomes are all high gloss smooth gel coated fiberglass for easy cleaning and durability and your motorhome is given a choice of either the tough 460 Ford E.F.I. (electronic fuel injection) engine with Ford's high quality and 6 years or 60,000 mile power train warranty. This chassis is a winner, but for you Chevy fans, The Heartbeat of America, Today's Chevy Truck with the 454 engine has been proven over millions of miles. It, too, has a 6 year or 60,000 mile power train warranty. No matter which chassis you choose, your AIREX motorhome has been precisely balanced to blend with the air.

Why is it the competition never shows a real photograph of their steel roll cage? Could it be they don't have a real steel roll cage? Well, at Rexhall we do, and we're proud of it. Every AIREX motorhome is built with our Unibody design. This means we take a complete steel roll cage and weld it directly to the chassis to form a structurally advanced Unibody design (an AIREX exclusive). After this, we vacuum bond Dyrotec .060" fiberglass to 1/4" luan, then fasten to roll cage. In the next step the interior is completely sprayed with polyurethane foam for the finest insulation and structural integrity.

Looking into the cockpit area you'll see a large 13" optional T.V. for easy viewing from any seat, while parked. Also, overhead console and cabinet ends are padded for safety. Sofa front folds down for storage of dining room table and extra large cocktail table or other items. Notice the large flush mount Norcold refrigerator surrounded with loads of solid oak doors and drawers. The pantry has fiberglass shelves for easy clean-up. Driver and passenger seats both recline and swivel around to become part of the living room area. Larger windows and real wood mini blinds, overstuffed sofa and "tickle your toes" carpet says, "This is Home!"
